

Antelope Place Doubles (page 1 of 2) A twin-hunt method similar to Grandsire Doubles, but with places in 4-5 instead of dodges.

Just like in Grandsire, Antelope Bobs and Singles affect the front bells differently, while the back work (sometimes referred to as "2-dodge-3" or "3-dodge-2") is the same for both calls.

When an Antelope SINGLE is called:
